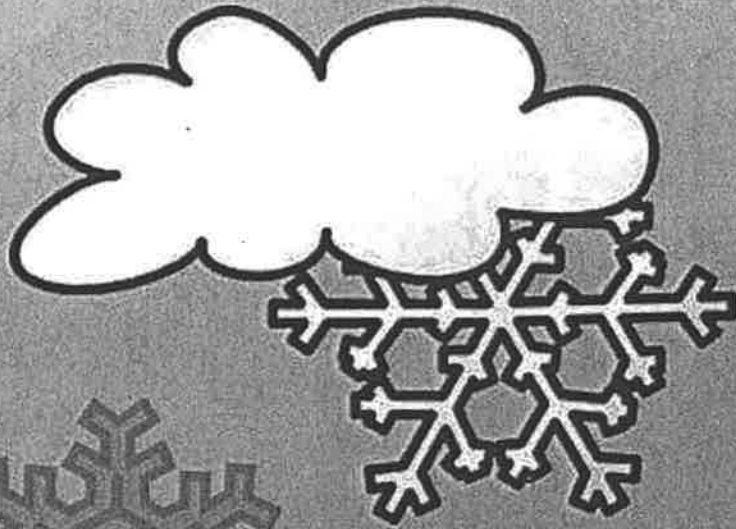

# Adverb – Adding to the Verb

An adverb is a word that tells when an action happens.

Examples: Can Fred come over tomorrow?

When can Fred come over?

Tomorrow tells when Fred can come over.

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## ‘HOW’ Adverb Focus



Adverbs describe *verbs, adjectives, or other adverbs*.  
An adverb gives us information about the way something is done.

We calmly walked towards the fire extt.

*‘Calmly’ describes HOW we walked.*

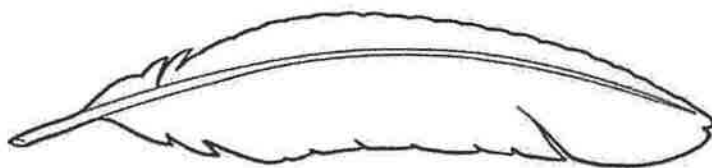
