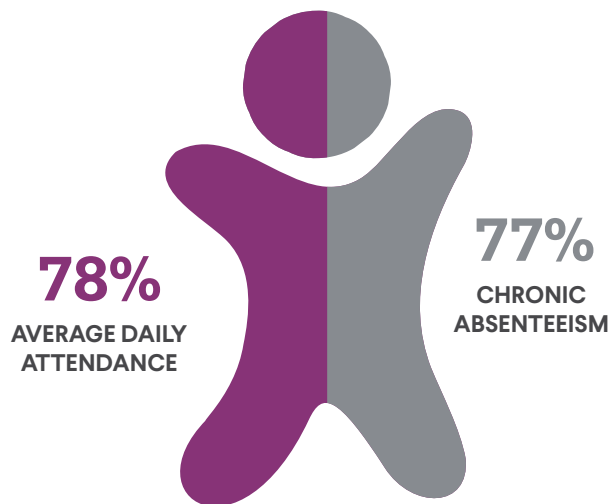
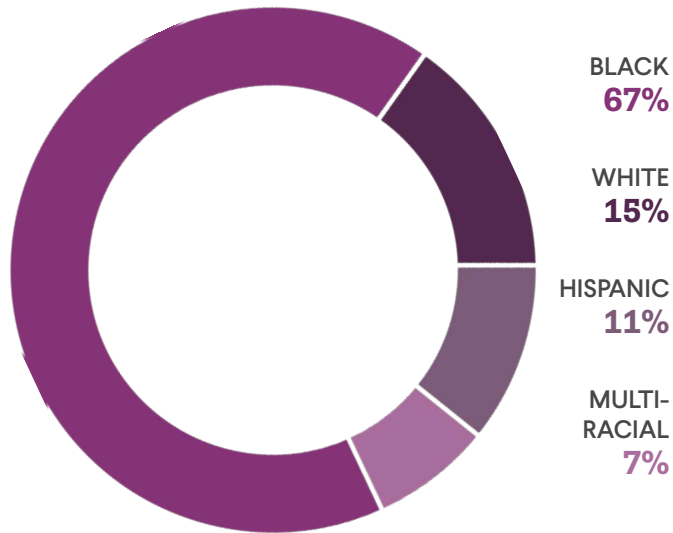

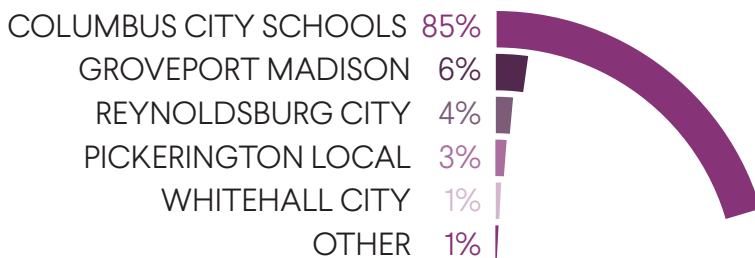

## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



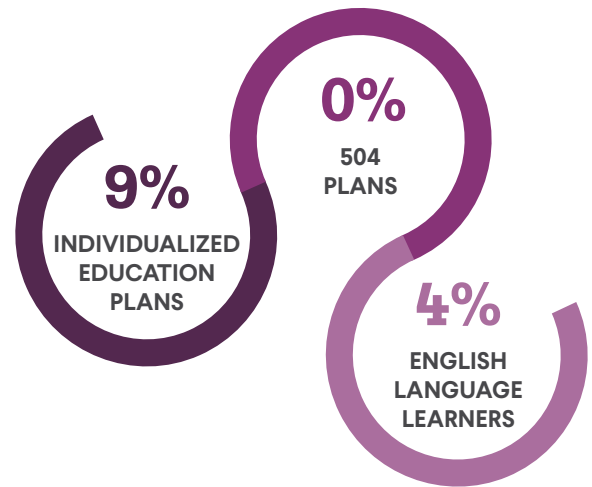
## DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

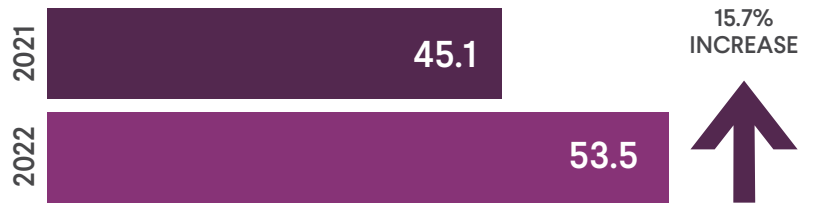
